Guided hike Tulfes

We take the Glungezerbahn to the mountain station. From there, we trudge on snowshoes along snow-covered paths to

our destination, the summit cross on the Schartenkogel. The view of the Karwendel, Inntal and Voldertal valleys is fantastic from here. On the way back, we fortify ourselves with Tyrolean delicacies at the Tulflein Alm. You then return to the lift station and take the cable car back down into the valley.

Please note: An alternative hike takes place outside the operating times of the Glungezerbahn.

→ 2 PM | EARTHQUAKES, PLAGUE AND FIRES

Themed tour Hall

Earthquakes, famines, epidemics, floods and fires presented the people of Hall with great challenges centuries ago and forced them to act together. A different look back into Hall's past, which also covers the general history of the town.

Mint Museum Hall

Up to the Mint Tower, Hall's landmark, and the permanent exhibition of the museum in Hasegg Castle this varied tour, which covers the history of Hall as a princely minting center and birthplace of the First Thaler of the World. An unforgettable view of the Karwendel and Tyrol's largest old town round off this themed tour.

Guided hike Gnadental

On the way along untouched, snow-covered paths and trails, we keep an eye out for various animal tracks. Equipped with Swarovski binoculars, wild animals, mainly chamois and mouflons, can be observed from afar, even in winter. An experience in the great outdoors!

Attention: In case of lack of snow a normal hike (without snowshoes) takes place.

→ 10 AM | NATURE WATCH IN WINTER – TRACKS IN THE SNOW

Guided hike in the Karwendel Nature Park

With a Tyrolean nature guide and equipped with Swarovski binoculars, we hike into the Halltal valley and learn lots of interesting facts about the flora and fauna. The peace and quiet of winter in Austria's largest nature park offer an ideal opportunity to observe fascinating wild animals such as chamois and ibex in their natural habitat. An unforgettable experience!

The regular guided tours are held in German and English.
All guided tours take place with one person.

All hikes and active hours take place with a minimum of two persons with registration the day before at the Hall Tourist Office by 5 pm (exceptions listed in the text). If the registration deadline falls on a public holiday, registration must be completed by 12 noon on the previous working day at the latest. Appropriate equipment is required (mountain boots, drink ...)
