CULINARY FORAY

DELICIOUS THROUGH THE REGION

HALLER RADISH MARKET

The area around the villages of Thaur and Absam is often described as "Austria's largest vegetable garden". 60% of all radishes and many other vegetable varieties grown in Austria are cultivated here. The harvest is celebrated at the Radish Market at Stiftsplatz in Hall with music, local delicacies and of course a lot of radishes.

MOUNTAIN MYTH HIKING TRAIL

MULTI-DAY LONG-DISTANCE TOUR IN THE KARWENDEL AND THE TUX ALPS

The new long-distance hiking trail in the Hall Wattens region takes you around the region in 5 daily legs. The start and end point are on the edge of the Karwendel Nature Park, but in between you pass through the Tux Alps as well as the small villages of the region and the town of Hall in Tirol. Overnight stays are in accommodation in the villages of the region. In addition to powerful places in the region, you will also find a myth about the surrounding area on each leg.

STONE PINE DAYS AT THE GLUNGEZER

The stone pine, also called "Queen of the Alps", is very prevalent at the Glungezer mountain. Here, where the largest Swiss stone pine forest in Central Europe is located and its characteristic scent is in the air, we celebrate Tyrol's third Swiss stone pine days. Guided tours on natural history, carver artists and workshops in the wood round off the Swiss stone pine days high above the Hall-Wattens region.

- · Visit the return of the cattle from the alpine pasture with farm festival at the Friedrichshof in Absam




MOUNTAIN WINTER IN THE HEART OF THE ALPS
